

BRISTOL TABLE TENNIS REPORT for WEEK NOs 3 and 4

I apologise for the delay in getting the latest results and data to you but I have been unable to send any e-mails out (very frustrating) Thanks to sterling efforts by Ricky Lemmoy I am now back in business.

At this stage in the season it is unusual to have so few hundred percent teams and players and it bodes well for a very competitive season.

Premier Division

After only four weeks there is no hundred percent side in the division, in fact there are only three unbeaten teams which indicates that the title will be closely contested.

Even more interesting is the fact that only Dave Reeves and David Harvey are undefeated.

Failand A are playing under the handicap of only having two fit players.

Division 1

There are four hundred percent teams who are also the only unbeaten teams. There is no early indication as to where to place your money at the bookies. There are five unbeaten players.

Six sets went to five in the match between Winterbourne A and Cleeve Adders a total of 792 points for the evening. Adders defeated two player Page A and Ocelots defeated two player Yate B.

Division 2

There are no hundred percent teams in this division and only four undefeated teams. Three players are unbeaten and they have only played one match!

Division 3

Two teams are hundred percent but have only played one match and there are seven undefeated players, Martin Youings having played three matches.

Almonds D whitewashed Pumas who must have felt somewhat aggrieved as five sets went to five and a total of 820 points were played. Almonds E defeated two player Creams.

Division 4

Three hundred percent teams with Westbury A leading the way with Mambas set average looking threatening. There are only two unbeaten players at this stage.

Mambas narrowly retained their hundred percent when they scraped past two player Raiders.

Division 5

Only two hundred percent teams in the division and two others who are unbeaten. There are four unbeaten players.

Keith Ambrose of Cougars failed to gain a set against Yatton but having lost two sets 8-11 10-12 14-16 and 9-11 15-13 7-11 11-13 and going to four in the other must have kicked the cat when he got home.

Division 6

There are two hundred percent teams and two other unbeaten teams with four unbeaten players.

Tigers did well to take Page D with only two players and with a full side defeated Tornadoes in a closer match than the score suggests.

Division 7

Again there are only two unbeaten sides with six unbeaten players.

Division 8
