Premier Division

With the two top teams not playing Panthers moved to within three sets of second placed Failand B by defeating Academy A. Fourth placed Academy B fielding a reserve narrowly went down to Almonds A. Fielding three players, Failand A won a close match with Knowle B.

Yate A and Cobras played a hard fought draw with no maximums in the match. Steve Hall's three steered Bristol A to a valuable win over Knowle A but it may prove to be too late to preserve their premiership status. With two players Knowle B gained a necessary draw against Academy A.

Division 1

Two wins for Nomads over Adders and Winterbourne A kept them at the top of the division while second placed Ocelots were awarded a walkover Portishead A. Third placed Almonds C had a comfortable win against struggling Portishead A who also narrowly lost to Yate B with two players, reserve Steve Doidge taking all three against his old club. Bristol C defeated bottom club Knowle C who only fielded two players.

Division 2

Leaders, KCC A, had a big win over two player Bristol E but are being closely challenged by non-playing Civets and Stokedene. Third placed Failand C had a big win against struggling KCC B to move level with Civets but have played two matches more. Rattlers remained in the chase with a win over Almonds B

Division 3

First and second placed Westbury D and Almonds D played their home and away matches with Westbury gaining the honours with a win and a draw and are looking serious contenders for the title.

Westbury B had two big wins against Pumas and two player Fromeside B to move into fourth spot. Fromeside B again with two players managed to gain a draw with Olympus. Creams, still to draw a match, narrowly defeated Congresbury to help them in a very closely contested second relegation spot.

Division 4

Division 5

Division 8

Kestrels moved to the top of the division with a whitewash of Portishead H a walkover Britannias and a win against club mates Eagles. Harambee defeated Eagles but conceded an walkover to them from an earlier season match catch up.

Kyle Zhou took the only three sets for Typhoons when they went down to Harambee. Cheetahs also defeated Typhoons to be in second place but the promotion places are in the hands of the third and fourth placed teams, Page G and Portishead G.
