Premier Division

Failand B defeated Cobras to hold second spot fourteen sets behind Brigands. Third placed Panthers had a bad night going down to Knowle A who only fielded two players. Failand A were reinforced by Gary Baldwin as they gained a narrow win over Bristol A for whom Steve Hall was unbeaten.

Cobras did well to hold Academy B to a valuable draw in their battle against relegation. Thanks to three from Paul Hooper Knowle B got the better of Academy B for whom Tim O'Mahoney made a rare appearance. Toby Mattacott and Vitas Rybakas took all three for Academy A as they defeated Yate A inflicting the first defeats this season on Dave Harvey. Another three for Steve Hall gave Bristol A a win over Knowle B improving their chances of remaining in the premier division.

Division 1

Almonds C retained top spot with a whitewash of bottom club Knowle C. Ocelots remain third by defeating Page A in an intriguing three horse promotion race. Yate B defeated Knowle C to keep them out of the relegation zone.

Division 2

Leaders KCC A had a big win over Fromeside C and then despite three from Paul Redman were held to a draw by fellow title contenders Civets.

Two close wins for Failand C against Warriors and Bobcats kept them in third place. Vernon Adams and Geoff Mallett having an incredible 16-14 17-19 8-11 14-12 11-5 set the second highest since 11 up was introduced.

Division 3

Westbury D defeated Olympus but were held to a draw by Congresbury, nevertheless they head the division by thirteen sets. Almonds D had a big win over their relegation threatened E team. Mark Quinn and Chris Webster equalled the highest five game set points total since 11 up.
