### Week 03

#### Premier

Leaders, Failand A, drew with Brigands, Dan Ives taking all three for Brigands. Failand A then whitewashed struggling Hercules who also lost to fellow strugglers Winterbourne A and now hold bottom place. A weakened Panthers side went down to Knowle B, Paul Hooper defeating Trevor Lloyd.

#### Division 1

Nomads defeated Knowle D and had a big win against Ocelots to move to the top of the division. Almonds A moved up to fifth spot with a win over Bristol C. Adders handed a heavy defeat to struggling Knowle D who now prop up the division.

Portishead just got the better of Yate B thanks to three from Gary Pincott. Portishead A fielded a full team and thanks to Paul Hawking defeated Rattlers.

#### Division 2
