

## BRISTOL & DISTRICT TABLE TENNIS 2006-7

### Week 06

Four one hundred percent records fell this week. Brian Pearson (Portishead E) against Chris Parker (Yatton), Graham Brown (Page B) against Peter Pitchford (Bristol H), Danny Burns (Knowle F) against Pete Lodge (Page G) and Pete Lodge (Page G) against Neil Boone (Knowle F)

### Premier

Failand A took over the leadership of the division with a comfortable win over their B side. Knowle B in third place defeated two player Winterbourne A. Despite only a draw against Knowle A and a defeat at the hands of Brigands, Yate A moved into joint fourth spot with Brigands who gained a big win over Bristol A.

### Division 1

Cobras look as though they will return to the premier division. They whitewashed Bristol C and defeated Knowle C to open a thirteen set gap although they have replayed a match more than their pursuers. Second placed Almonds A had a very much closer win than the score suggests against Rattlers.

### Division 2

### Division 3

Yate C with only two players had their first win defeating higher placed Almonds D who then lost to lower placed Westbury D.

### Division 4

A win against Bristol D and a hard fought draw against Portishead D took Fromeside B to the top of the division. Previous leaders Congresbury drew with Bristol D but lost heavily to third placed Almonds E.

A good win over Beavers with their earlier draw took Portishead D into fourth place. Bottom placed Longwell closed the gap above them with a win over Page C who are just above them.

### Division 5

#### Division 6

Leaders, Knowle E drew with Almonds F, Michelle Leonard losing to Hayley Ruderham in five. Page E were surprisingly taken close by Polecats, Andy Baker losing two sets. Against the stronger Leopards side Page E had a much easier win.

Third placed Pythons without Graham Budd were taken close by two player Boost. A big win by Boost against Bristol F (who insist on calling themselves the H team) took them to fourth spot. Bristol H, sorry F, lost to Leopards and are still looking for their first win of the season.

#### Division 7
