

BRISTOL & DISTRICT TABLE TENNIS 2006-7

Week 08

Premier

Failand A moved to the top of the division by inflicting the first defeat of the season on previous leaders Academy and beating Bristol A. Knowle A whitewashed joint bottom placed Hercules.

Division 1

Cobras maintained their hundred percent record with a big win over Yate B and opened an eight set gap at the top of the division. Second placed Knowle C were held by Adders despite three from Andrew Castaldi.

Division 2

A big win by Civets over two player Creams lifted them into second place by one set over non-playing Page A. Paul Redman's three gave KCC C a close win over Bristol E to move temporarily into fourth spot.

Stokedene had a comfortable win against Fromeside C to hold fifth place. Hawks, thanks to a maximum from Dave Nipper, drew with Almonds B to halt their run of seven losses.

Division 3

Civil Service C held on to top spot by narrowly defeating second placed Bobcats, no player managing a three. Third placed Civil Service F were held by Westbury D despite three from Geoff Dyer. Westbury D then saw off Failand D who are still without a win. Failand missed their chance of a win going down to two player Almonds D.

Westbury A turned the tables on their compatriots Westbury B aided by an injury to Paul Wilmot in a high scoring match.

Division 4

With leaders, Pegasus being held by second placed Portishead D, Congresbury got the better of Fromeside B to join them at the top of the table with a match in hand. Two wins for Bristol D over Page C and Beavers took them into fourth place. Longwell were held to a draw by Failand E owing to three from Dean Leppier.

Division 5

Leaders, Portishead E, lost their unbeaten record to Page B allowing Mambas to close the gap on them with their whitewash of Cougars and very close win over previously second placed Yatton.

Avspol had a big win against Tornadoes to move into fourth place with matches in hand on Yatton. Yate D had a good win over Bristol H but lost a place to Almonds G who defeated two player Page D.

Division 6

Knowle E were taken surprisingly close by Portishead F but pulled further away from second placed Page E who went down to Civil Service E, for whom Sangha Pratihari took all three. The strong Pythons team had a comfortable win against Polecats and are poised ominously in third place. Sangha Pratihari took another three for Civil Service E when they defeated struggling Bristol F and moved into fourth spot. Westbury C defeated Almonds F who were without John Ruderham.

Division 7

Vipers retained their hundred percent record with good tight wins over second and fourth placed opposition, Jaguars and Winterbourne B to hold a seven set advantage at the top of the division.

Tim Coles took all three for Portishead G but couldn't prevent them from losing to KCC D. Kestrels won a very high scoring match against Mints to ease a little further from the relegation zone.

Division 8

Knowle G held on to top place with a close win over third placed Page G. Knowle F moved into second place with a win over Civil Service B and a draw against Eagles for whom Dave Sellick was unbeaten.

Thanks to three from John Cox Cheetahs gained a narrow victory over Civil Service B who went on to record their first win, defeating Page H.

Three from William Zhu gave Almonds a win over Britannias who held KCC E to a draw.
