Week 15

Premier

Panthers defeated third placed Brigands thanks to three from Ricky Jemmott. Panthers then lost narrowly to Knowle A. Two big wins for Yate A over Hercules and two player Failand B took them into fourth place

Division 1

Second placed Almonds A defeated fourth placed Knowle C who were held to a draw by Yate B. Adders had a big win over Knowle D despite strong resistance from Jess Orlik. Struggling Rattlers drew with Portishead B but went down to Portishead A.

Division 2

Leaders Almonds C retained their hundred percent record with a narrow win against fourth placed KCC C. and a whitewash of one player Failand C. With a full team Failand C defeated Almonds B. Bristol E defeated Creams in a closer match than the score suggests. Fromeside C narrowly defeated Creams in an important lower table battle.

Division 3

Division 4
